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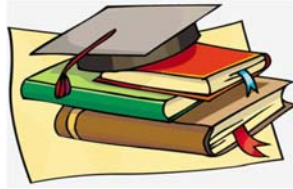
Well Hello Everyone:

Grade 9—12 Attendance Policy:

- ◆ A student will be marked absent if he/she is ten (10) or more minutes late to a double period or five (5) minutes to a half period (i.e. Band, ICT, Family Studies, etc.).
- ◆ The student will be expected to wait **quietly** at the classroom door until the teacher addresses the student's tardiness. **It is up to the teacher whether or not to allow the student to enter the classroom**
- ◆ You will be receiving an email or letter when your child has missed five and ten classes.
- ◆ **After your child has missed ten classes, you and your child will be required to attend a meeting with the teacher and/or principal to identify the barriers/obstacles preventing regular attendance and to develop a plan to prevent future absences. 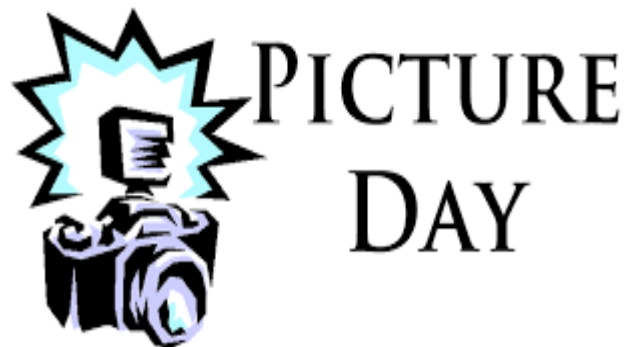

We have put posters up around town to remind people of the food drive the school will be doing on Halloween afternoon from 1:00-2:00 pm.

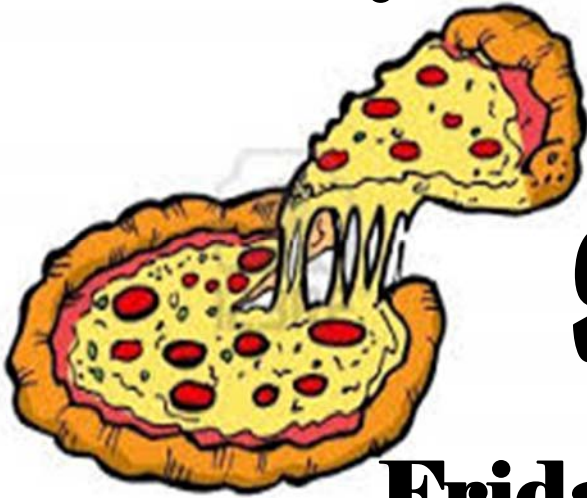
2018 Ste. Rose School Terry Fox Walk

Ste. Rose has once again generously supported fundraising efforts for the Terry Fox Foundation. Students and staff of the school accompanied by many family members, along with staff and children from the Charlie Brown Day Care Centre, helped to keep Terry's dream alive by taking part in the annual Terry Fox School Walk on Friday Sept. 28. Appreciation is extended to Constable Aitken for providing the RCMP escort. Following the walk, a hot dog lunch was held in the gym. The lunch was sponsored by Ste. Rose IGA, Ste. Rose Super Thrifty Pharmacy, and Ste. Rose Shop Easy Foods and Weston Bakery with the Ste. Rose school student council providing cookies for dessert. A total of \$2817.75 was raised for cancer research, including \$1092.75 in profits from the hotdog sale and the "Toonies for Terry" campaign, \$1570.00 in pledges from students and their parents, school staff and the community, and \$155.00 in online pledges. Appreciation is extended to Ms. Ogg for coordinating the event, to Mrs. Marshall for looking after the collection of fundraising and pledge money, and to everyone who assisted with preparing and distributing the lunch. Thank-you also to the staff at Super Thrifty Pharmacy, Canada Post office, and Sunrise Credit Union for helping to collect pledges.

Paul Raffray wishes to thank all those who continue to support his fundraising efforts each year. Since Ste. Rose School became a Terry Fox run site in 2001, \$43,400 has been raised for the Terry Fox foundation, including pledges collected by Paul during his solo runs from 1981 to 2000. Ste. Rose and area has raised \$56,000.00 for cancer research.!
